The weights of grades are as follows:

Participation and Homework

- Each week you will receive 10 participation points.
- Expect the occasional homework quiz: HW turned in ~40%, HW quiz ~60%
- **Late Work** – Assignments turned in within 2 days have a 10% deduction. Work turned in after that will have a 50% deduction. Homework that is in your car, at home, or in your locker is treated as late work.
- You will have 2 homework passes (no late points taken off) a semester. If you are able to turn both in at the end of the semester, you will not have to do the last chapter review assignment and receive a 100%.
- You must show work to receive credit on homework.
- **Extra Credit** - There may be extra credit available from time to time, however I expect you to do well on what is done under the normal curriculum. Please do not ask for extra credit. Take advantage of the opportunities I give to you to improve your grade throughout the year.
